The Odisha State Board of Madrasa Education (OSBME) was formed by the Government of Odisha in the year 1971, before the formation, the Madrasa students' examination in the state was conducted by the Bihar Madrasa Board. The students had to face a lot of difficulties during their study due to the conduct of examination and award of certificates from other state.

In view of these problems, the Government of Odisha, taken a historic decision to make education accessible in the state and for the convenience of its students, established the Odisha State Board of Madrasa Education (OSBME) in the year 1971 by passing resolution under the State Government Education Rules, since then till now the Odisha State Board of Madrasa Education (OSBME) is continuously working for the promotion of education. Setting another milestone in this direction, OSBME has taken a step towards modern education system by starting distance mode education programme in the Board.

OSBME has started Distance Mode Education Programme for class 10th/Secondary/مولوی and 12th/ Senior Secondary/مابّر from session 2024-2025 with its Pan India Partner Subsidiary Organization Patrachar Shiksha Parishad (PSP) with the approval of the Government of Odisha to make education easy and accessible to the general public and to strengthen the Board by connecting it with modern education system.

FEATURES AND FLEXIBILITIES IN OSBME

1. Age Limit:

There is no upper age limit for admission. However, the minimum age for enrolment in Secondary /10th/مولوی course is 14 years, Should be completed as on starting of New Session, the minimum age for enrolment in Senior Secondary /12th/ماہر course is 16 years, should be completed as on starting of New Session.

2. Validity of Admission:

Candidate admission is valid for five years .For Public Examination at Secondary /10th/مولوی and Senior Secondary /12th/ماہر level, candidate may take nine chances to successfully complete the course during this period.

3. Choice in Subjects and Medium of Instructions:

OSBME offers its courses in Urdu, English and Hindi medium. Candidate can choose any of the medium for studies. Candidate can choose any subject combination from the list of subjects offered as per the criteria given in the OSBME Scheme of Studies. Candidate should choose subjects carefully keeping in view your plans for higher studies, job requirements and requirement of Board/Universities which Candidate wish to join after passing the Secondary and Senior Secondary Course from OSBME.

- Two language subjects from group A are permissible for certification. However, third language can be offered as an additional subject.
- Only one subject can opted as additional subject from group a on the other side from group B candidate can choose one or two additional subjects.

One or Two additional Subject (s) can also be selected either at the time of admission or during the course of Study, If the candidate is so desired or if it is required.(Additional subject fee will be different from the main fee, No Additional fee will be charge from the candidates who choose traditional subjects for **ماہر**)

- Five Subjects with two languages (One compulsory –One Optional).
- Minimum of five subjects.
- Two additional subject can also be taken.
- The Learners are however advised to select the subjects as per their future plan of study and work.
- Two language subjects from group A are permissible for certification. However, third language can be offered as an additional subject.
- Only one subject can opted as additional subject from group a on the other side from group B candidate can choose one or two additional subjects.

4. Flexible Scheme of Examination:

Public examination is conducted by OSBME twice in a year Like National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS). Candidate will get nine chances to appear in the public examination over a period of 5 Years of registration.

The OSBME is a State Govt. Board for Secondary/ 10th/ **مولوی** and Senior Secondary/12th/ **ماہر** Examinations, similar to the all-state Boards, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) & National Institute of Open schooling (NIOS).

The Public Examinations will be held twice a year in the months of April-May and October-November on dates fixed by the OSBME. However, you are also eligible to appear through On Demand Examination at Secondary level and Senior Secondary level in those subjects only in which you can have admission in OSBME. To appear for the OSBME examination, you must register yourself by filling up the Admission-Cum-Examination Form and paying requisite fee as per schedule given.

- (i) For April-May Examination :
Till 31st December (without Late fee), from 01st January to 31st January (With Late Fee) and from 1st Feb to 20th Feb with consolidated Late Fee.
- (ii) For October-November Examination:
Till 30th June (without Late fee), from 01st July to 31st July (With Late Fee) and from 1st August to 20th August with consolidated Late Fee.

(There may be changes in the Exam schedule as per the decision of the Board.)

5. Credit Accumulation:

You can choose to appear in any one or more than one subjects in any examination and earn credits which will be accumulated till all subjects required for certification are successfully completed within a period of 5 years of registration.

6. Transfer of Credit and Re- admission:

The facility of Transfer of Credit is imparting to the candidates of the CBSE/NIOS/ State Govt. boards, other recognized State /Center Notified Boards and Member Boards of CBSE, who have failed in Secondary & Senior Secondary Examination. In this facility credit of all passed subjects will be transferred and learner has the freedom to appear only in those particular subjects in which he/she remained unsuccessful, but these subject should be available in OSBME Scheme of Studies. In addition to this, learner has option to change failed subjects as already opted as per scheme of studies except compulsory subjects required for certification.

7. Part Admission:

Under this scheme, you may take admission in one or more subject but not more than four subject. On passing, you will be issued the Marks sheet only.

8. Scheme Of Studies :

For Obtaining Pass Certificate a candidate is required to pass in minimum of five subjects including of two Compulsory Languages from Group A and three Subject from Group B. However, a candidate is free to take up two additional Subjects. Thus in all maximum of seven subjects can be chosen.

ADMISSION FOR THE LEARNERS WHO WANT TO APPEAR UNDER THE ON DEMANDS EXAMINATION SYSTEMS (ODES):

The basic concept of On Demand Examination is that OSBME Student can walk into the examination center as and when he/she feel ready for the examination similarly like (SIOS) ODISHA and (NIOS). OSBME will organize on demand Exams two time in a year. Students can appear in following subjects at Secondary and Sr. Secondary level through the On Demand Examination:

- ❖ Secondary: Urdu, Hindi, English, Odia, Regional Languages, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Quran –O –Hadith, Arabic, Fiquah + Persian, Painting, Home science, Physical Education, Computer Science.
- ❖ Sr. Secondary: Urdu, Hindi, English, Odia, Regional Languages, History, Geography, Political Science, Economics, Tafseer–O–Aqait, Hadith Osool-E-Hadith + Fiquah-O-Osool-E-Fiquah, Persian, Arabic Literature, Home Science, Sociology, Philosophy, Psychology, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Accountancy, Business Studies & Management, Business Mathematics & Statistics, Environmental Studies Information Technology, Physical Education.

- Medium of Question Paper: English, Urdu, Odia and Hindi Medium Only.

The advantages of ODES can be stated as follows:

- Allows the Student to get assessed when he/ she is ready. Readiness depends on the Student and not on the institution.
- Attempts to remove the stress of appearing in examination(s), whether for all subjects or in one subject at a fixed time and schedule.
- Attempts to remove the threat of failure in examination.
- Removes frustration, loss of self-esteem, peer group ridicule, depression etc.
- Knowledge of results is almost immediate and success even in one subject, is a strong motivating factor.
- Degree and level of performance is decided by the Student who can reappear in the examination as many times as one wants, till satisfied.
- Respects the individuality and sovereignty of each Student

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR OSBME ADMISSION IN 10TH CLASS (SECONDARY) :

- Candidate age should be complete 14 years for taking admission in 10th/ Secondary Course.
- 6th, 7th 8th or 9th Class Pass School leaving certificate or 10th class failure Certificate should be attached with Admission form.
- Address Proof like AADHAR CARD (Parent's)/Rent Agreement (if rented).
- Cast certificate (if belongs to Backward Classes).
- Certificate from a Government Hospital for a handicapped person.
- Original failure/compartament Mark sheet of class 10th for TOC (Transfer of credit).
- Two Latest Colored Photographs (Passport Size).

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR OSBME ADMISSION IN 12TH CLASS (SR. SECONDARY) :

- Candidate age should be complete 16 years for taking admission in 12th Senior Secondary Course.
- Scan/Photocopy of 10th class passed Mark sheet.
- Address Proof like AADHAR CARD (Parent's)/Rent Agreement (if rented).
- Cast Certificate (if belongs to Backward Classes).
- Certificate from a Government Hospital for a handicapped person
- Original Failure/ Compartment without Laminated Mark sheet of class 12th for TOC (Transfer of credit).
- Two Latest Colored Photographs (Passport Size).

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR OSBME ON DEMAND ADMISSION IN 10TH CLASS (SECONDARY) :

- 6th, 7th 8th or 9th Class Pass School leaving certificate or 10th class Failed Original without laminated mark sheet or Admit Card.
- Address Proof like AADHAR CARD (Parent's)/Rent Agreement (if rented).
- Cast Certificate (if belongs to Backward Classes).
- Original Failure/ Compartment without Laminated Mark sheet of class 10th for TOC (Transfer of credit).

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR OSBME ON DEMAND ADMISSION IN 12TH CLASS (SR. SECONDARY) :

- 12th class Failed Original without laminated mark sheet or Admit Card.
- Address Proof like AADHAR CARD (Parent's)/Rent Agreement (if rented).
- Cast Certificate (if belongs to Backward Classes).
- Original Failure/ Compartment without Laminated Mark sheet of class 10th for TOC (Transfer of credit).
- Two Latest Colored Photographs (Passport Size).

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

Your admission will be cancelled:

- If the admission form is incomplete.
- If the fee paid is short.
- If the supporting documents are not complete.
- If false documents have been submitted.
- If required educational qualifications are not fulfilled.
- If the minimum age criteria is not fulfilled.

- If incorrect or wrong information is given.
- If the Secondary examination is not passed from a recognized board.
- If residential proof is not attached.

STUDY MATERIAL:

Students after getting registered to OSBME can get the syllabus and books just by providing the correct address and details to the Board from which they have register to OSBME. The books will then be dispatched and delivered to the address mentioned in the form filled by the student. The student should be very careful while getting there form filled. After receiving the study material, Students can even refer to other books if he/she is wants deep knowledge of a particular topic mentioned in the books provided by the study material of OSBME. Soon, the study material process is going to be very easy and fast because OSBME is going to launch the online study material facility for the learners, so with one click you will be able to save the study material in your folder.

PERSONAL CONTACT PROGRAMME (PCP):

OSBME students study at their own using self-instructional material. However, while learning they do confront certain problems and need various types of help and guidance. For clarification of their doubts, OSBME conducts 30 Personal Contact Programme (PCPs) for theory subjects out of which 15 are compulsory. Five additional PCPs are allotted for subjects having practical's, on face to face basis, generally on weekends and holidays, by the Admission & Information Centre (AI).

COURSE OF STUDIES FOR DISTANCE MODE EDUCATION PROGRAMME

OSBME Supporting flexible system of study by introducing modern education system along with traditional education in Madrasa Board through distance mode programme. Therefore, students who want to appear for **ماہر** and **مولوی** examination only through traditional Scheme of Studies can appear for it, and students who want to appear for Secondary and Senior Secondary examination through flexible and modern Scheme of Studies can appear for it.

COURSE OF STUDIES FOR SECONDARY/10TH/ مولوی

The learner needs to study five subjects with compulsory two languages and remaining other three subjects as per choice. Each subject carries 100 marks; in subjects with practical, the weightage accorded is theory-85%, practical-15%. Two Additional Subject can also be add from group A & Group B. Only one subject can opted as additional subject from group A on the other side from group B candidate can choose one or two additional subjects. In Secondary Education Course means Minimum five subject & with additional subjects Maximum Seven Subject.

COURSE OF STUDIES FOR SENIOR SECONDARY/12TH/ ماہر

The learner needs to study five subjects with either one or maximum two languages and the remaining subjects as per choice. Each subject carries 100 marks. For subjects with practical, the weightage accorded is theory-70%, practical-30%. Two Additional Subject can also be add, from group A only one subject can opted as additional subject on the other side from group B candidate can choose one or two additional subjects. In Senior Secondary Education Course means Minimum five subject & with additional subjects Maximum Seven Subject.
